

UA Parking Policy

327 – CONSTRUCTION AND CONTRACTOR PARKING

This policy outlines the guidelines for parking access and permit requirements for contractors and construction personnel working on campus. The goal is to minimize the impact of contractor vehicles on faculty, staff, and student parking availability while ensuring contractors have the access needed to complete their work efficiently and safely.

Permit Options

1. Zone-Based Construction Permits

- Construction vehicles are assigned to a specific campus parking zone (Zone 1–4). These permits allow parking only in Faculty/Staff or Commuter lots within that assigned zone, as well as Lot 232, 320, 321, 322, and 500.

2. All-Zone Construction Permits

- All-Zone Construction Permits allow parking in Faculty/Staff or Commuter lots across campus. These permits are reserved for contractors with campus-wide responsibilities that require access to multiple locations and are issued on a case-by-case basis.

3. Project-Specific Reserved Spaces

- A limited number of 24-hour reserved parking spaces may be designated outside the construction site. These spaces will be signed specifically for the contractor assigned to them and charged monthly at the current 24-Hour Reserved parking rate.

Permits are assigned by project location and issued in limited quantities per zone. Once a zone has reached its approved permit capacity, additional permits for that zone will not be issued. In these cases, contractors may be issued an alternative zone with available capacity or purchase an Economy Permit, which allows parking in Lot 500.

Construction permits must be requested through an online form found on the Transit and Parking Services website. parking.uark.edu
