### **BASIC COMPETITION PARAMETERS**

The design competition will culminate in public presentations at the University of Arkansas. Presentations of design proposals will be digital. Design proposals will also be on display in a corresponding exhibition in the Fay Jones School, which will require four printed 36in x 48in boards with a corresponding physical model. The model will be roughly one cubic foot in size, and common bases will be provided.

### **COMPETITION STIPEND**

Each of the six shortlisted firms will receive a stipend of \$25,000 upon completion of the design competition.

### **SHORTLIST SELECTION AND COMPETITION JUDGING**

The selection of the shortlist will be made by a selection committee at the University of Arkansas. The design competition will be judged by three external critics who will be identified upon release of the shortlist. The external critics and the selection committee will generate a recommendation to the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, which will review the recommendation and make the final selection of competition winner.

### **PROJECT BUDGET**

Per the RFQ, the total project cost is \$16 million, which includes all hard and soft costs.
